* In a meeting held with Lt. General Shahid Iqbal Commander 5 Corps, Karachi, Mr. Ali S. Habib was informed of a 300 mile stretch where people are still stranded. Upon receiving Lt. General Shahid Iqbal's request, A team comprising of Mr. Saeed Jung, Mr. Altaf Nazim & Mr. Raza Ansari met the concerned people to identify the exact affected area & establish their requirements.



Rebuilding Phase Update...

For phase-2, the flood relief committee is now seriously looking into different options instead of the original plan of going in and rebuilding houses which were destroyed by the floods. Looking at the ground realities the committee has realized that building houses for selected few may create ill-feelings with those who will be living in close proximity and not having the same relief provided to them by House of Habib.

The options that were considered by the committee were either participating in the Punjab Government initiative of building model villages where a community which consists of 20 houses costing 5.5 million Rupees or a small village consisting of 50 houses costing 15 million Rupees can be adopted by House of Habib in Muzaffargarh district which includes some of the basties identified by Mr. Saqlain Akhtar where our employees who have been affected reside.

In Sindh around Habib Farms the committee felt that instead of getting involved in the actual re-construction of their houses we may provide them with building materials and they can rebuild their houses with the help of community members.

Medical Camps Update...

Medical camps in collaboration with HOPE & PMA were arranged in 8 different localities (basties) between 29 September to 12 October, 2010. The camps provided treatment & medicines to 4,085 patients of the following localities:
